Caribbean Promotions Arts & Culture Inc. will be presenting the 10th Annual Jerk Food Festival on Saturday & Sunday August 6 - 7, 2011 at Centennial Park, Etobicoke. ON. Gates open @ 11:00a.m. We are encouraging vendors to offer a wide variety of Jerk foods.

There are only Twenty (20) food booths available. The fee for a food-vending booth is ~~\$2,300.00~~ **\$1,700.00 plus HST** for the weekend; **Please note an additional \$350.00 is required as security deposit, which is refundable within 48 hours of the event providing there is no breach of the rules and regulations.** Payments should be made in full by either cash or money order to **Caribbean Promotions Arts & Culture Inc.** A deposit of \$700 is required on or before July 20, 2011, to secure the above rate for a returning vendor; full payment for all vending booth, must be received no later than **July 31, 2011** The sale of food booths are on a first come, first served basis.

Rules and Regulations

The following rules must be adhered to. Any breach of these rules however caused, will result in the voiding of this agreement or immediate ejection from the venue.

1. Each food vendor is expected to pay a security deposit of \$350.00 in addition to the cost of the booth space. This deposit will be reimbursed within 48 hours of the day of the event, providing that the vendor did not commit any breach of the agreement. Please note that all new vendors will bear the cost of a banner, which will be deducted from the security deposit. The vendor will get the banner to keep after the festival.
2. **ALL FOOD VENDORS MUST STOP SELLING AT 9:30P.M. SHARP ON THE BOTH DAYS. FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL RESULT IN THE LOSS OF THE SECURITY DEPOSIT AND BANNING FROM FUTURE PARTICIPATION IN JERK FOOD FESTIVAL.**
3. **ON THE DAY OF THE FESTIVAL, ALL VENDORS AND THEIR STAFF MUST BE AT THE PARK BETWEEN 6:00 A.M and 9:00 A.M. SHARP. THE CUT-OFF TIME FOR VENDOR ENTRY IN THE PARK IS 10 A.M. ABSOLUTELY NO ENTRY AFTER 10 A.M.**
4. All food vendors are expected to offer for sale meals starting at \$10.00. Sale of water, juice, pop, snow cone, corn and patties is not allowed. Any breach will result in the forfeiture of the security deposit.
5. VENDORS CAN ONLY SELL ITEMS LISTED ON THE VENDORS' AGREEMENT.
6. EACH VENDOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING THEIR IMMEDIATE AREA OF ALL GARBAGE THROUGHOUT THE EVENT AND AFTER THE EVENT. ALL GARBAGE MUST BE DISPOSED OF IN THE DUMPSTERS ON-SITE.
7. EACH VENDOR IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE HIS/HER OWN STANDBY GENERATOR. ELECTRICITY IS AVAILABLE ON-SITE BUT RELIABILITY CANNOT BE GUARANTEED.
8. Caribbean Promotions Arts & Culture Inc., or their associates are in no way responsible or will be held liable for personal injury, loss or adversity however caused, as a result of any incident or Act of God on the day of the festival that can be directly or indirectly attributed to any vendor/patron.
9. All booth locations in the park will be pre-assigned and labeled no changes will be accommodated.
10. Until the contract is signed and paid in full, application for vendors' space shall not be a binding contract with Caribbean Promotions Arts & Culture Inc.

ON SITE REGULATIONS

- Vendors may have their company name displayed at the front of their booth. All activities must be conducted within their allotted concession area.
- Vendors are expected to provide their own garbage bags to collect garbage generated from the days' sales. All vendors must ensure that their area is restored to its original state free of garbage. Garbage bags must be placed in the dumpsters provided.
- Any additional rules imposed by the park on the day must be followed.

Vendor's Booth sales are final, and are non-refundable.
